

User manual

Before use

Charge the vibrator completely before first use with the included USB cable. Plug the pin at the end of the charging cable into the charging point at the back of the vibrator. Connect the cable to a USB port. When the battery is charging, the LED lights on the handle blink. When the lights stop blinking and burn constantly, the battery is completely charged.

Turning on and off

Hold the power button at the handle for 3 seconds to turn on the toy. The vibrator will then start vibrating. When this is not the case, the battery is empty. Charge the battery first and then try again. After use, hold the button for 3 seconds to turn off the toy.

Operating

Scroll through the 8 different vibration settings with the power button and the arrow buttons at the handle. Press the power button to go to the next vibration pattern. Press the top button to increase the vibration speed. Press the lower button to decrease the vibration speed. There are 3 vibration speeds and 5 vibration patterns in total.

Lubricant

The head of the vibrator is made of silicone. Therefore the vibrator can only be used in combination with water-based lubricant. Other lubricants can negatively affect the material, allowing bacteria to grow and making it impossible to hygienically clean the toy.

Cleaning

Rinse the silicone head of the vibrator with lukewarm water. Apply toy cleaner to the silicone head and thoroughly rub it clean. Repeat this step if necessary. Rinse the silicone head with lukewarm water and lay the vibrator down to dry or dab it dry with a lint-free cloth or towel.

Storage

Safely store the vibrator at a dry and dark place.
Use a toy bag to protect the toy from dust and scratches.
